# Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) Between Lakeside Union School District and General Shafter School District

# I. Purpose

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by and between the Lakeside Union School District (hereinafter referred to as "Lakeside") and the General Shafter School District (hereinafter referred to as "General Shafter") for the purpose of establishing a collaborative agreement wherein Lakeside will provide school psychological assessments for students within the General Shafter School District on an as-needed basis, with billing based on the number of days required to complete the assessments.

# II. Scope of Services

- Assessment Services: Lakeside agrees to provide professional school psychological assessments to students referred by General Shafter. These assessments may include, but are not limited to, cognitive, academic, emotional, and behavioral evaluations.
- Multi-Day Service: Assessments provided by Lakeside will be conducted over the number of days necessary to complete each assessment thoroughly. This may include multiple days for testing, observations, and any necessary interviews.
- 3. Reporting: Following the assessment, Lakeside will provide a comprehensive report to General Shafter, including findings, recommendations, and any necessary follow-up actions. This report will be delivered within [specify time frame, e.g., 5 business days] following the completion of the assessment.

# III. Responsibilities of Lakeside Union School District

- 1. Provide qualified school psychologists to conduct assessments.
- 2. Ensure assessments are conducted in accordance with best practices and in compliance with all applicable state and federal laws.
- 3. Provide all necessary materials and resources for the completion of the assessments.
- 4. Maintain confidentiality of all student records and assessment results, in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and any other relevant laws.

### IV. Responsibilities of General Shafter School District

- Identify and refer students in need of psychological assessment services to Lakeside, providing all necessary background information and records.
- 2. Facilitate the scheduling of assessment days, ensuring that referred students are available and prepared for assessment.
- 3. Provide a suitable environment for the assessment to take place, including a quiet space free from interruptions.

Compensate Lakeside for the services provided, as outlined in the "Compensation" section of this MOU.

# V. Compensation

- 1. General Shafter agrees to compensate Lakeside for each day required to complete the assessment. The rate per day will be \$720.68.
- 2. Payment will be made within 30 days of receiving the assessment report.

### VI. Duration and Termination

- 1. This MOU will be effective from 8/26/2024 and will remain in effect until 6/1/2025, unless terminated earlier by either party.
- 2. Either party may terminate this MOU with 30 days written notice to the other party.

# VII. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising out of or in connection with this MOU shall be resolved through mutual discussions between the parties. If a resolution cannot be reached, the matter may be escalated to mediation or arbitration as agreed upon by both parties.

### VIII. Amendments

This MOU may be amended or modified only by a written agreement signed by authorized representatives of both parties.

### IX. Governing Law

This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of [insert state].
